CAB BASKETBALL



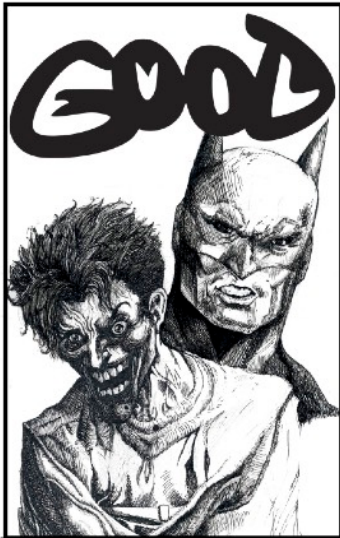
